



Tropic of Capricorn' Veteran Golf Carnival - 2024



CARNIVAL INFORMATION

General :

Each player must be a financial member of a registered Golf Club, have a current Golf Australia Handicap and be a financial member of a Men's or Women's Veteran Golf Club affiliated with the Australian Veteran Golders Union Inc.

Players, if asked, must supply proof of a financial membership of a Veterans Golf Club.

The rules of Golf shall apply and any club event Local Rules in operation at the time.

The Carnival may only be entered by using the Tropic Of Capricorn Carnival Entry Form.

Six daily golf events are played over 4 golf club venues - Rockhampton, North Rockhampton, Emu Park and Yeppoon.

Player nominations may be received for any number of daily or all venue events with payment of each event fee.

Event game will be played to daily current GA handicaps.

The following game types are set for the carnival.

Division/Grade 1 - Men/Women - Stroke

Division/Grade 2, 3 - Men/Women - Stableford

Note : Final Divisions/Grades are subject variance as to receipted player nomination GA handicap to form even distribution of player numbers across all division fields.

Note : Players at handicap division borderlines may experience daily event changes of division as with daily updates of their GA handicaps
All Division 1 players whose GA handicap lapses to Division 2 will play Stableford, but are asked to record on the score card full gross scores taken on every golf hole. Must Play out (Required for participants of 'Golfer/Player of Carnival' Competition.

GOLFER/PLAYER OF THE CARNIVAL COMPETITION CONDITIONS

In conjunction, using daily event results, golfers may further participate in a 'Golfer/Player of the Carnival' competition.

Veteran 'Golfer/Player of the Tropic of Capricorn' Veteran Golf Carnival titles and prizes will be awarded (men and women) for the best five (5) accumulated Gross and Nett scores (Division 1) and Stableford scores (Division 2 & 3) for games played over the carnival of which one (1) must be the Central Queensland Veterans Open on the last day.

Twelve (12) prizes for men and women over all advertised divisions.

One Major prize per player.

Men :-

Division 1 : Golfer of the Carnival - 5 Best Gross Scores.

Division 1 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Nett Scores.

Division 2 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 2 : Player of the Carnival Runner-up - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 3 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 3 : Player of the Carnival Runner-up - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Women :-

Division 1 : Golfer of the Carnival - 5 Best Gross Scores.

Division 1 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Nett Scores.

Division 2 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 2 : Player of the Carnival Runner-up - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 3 : Player of the Carnival - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Division 3 : Player of the Carnival Runner-up - 5 Best Stableford Scores.

Score System Format and Qualifications.

Eligibility, a player must pay an additional one only "Golfer/Player of the Carnival' entry Fee of \$30, must nominate for a minimum of 5 games of which one must be the Central Queensland Veterans Open on the last day.

A player's initial event game GA handicap will establish their division and held over the whole competition.

If total scores are tied, the Golfer/Player of the Carnival (men and Women) will be determined by count back of score results of the series final game. If still tied, the previous games scores will be used until the tie is broken.

A player winning both the Gross and Nett competition will be allocated the Gross only, per the one (1) prize policy.

All decisions by the Event Committee are final. The committee reserves the right to vary these conditions at their discretion when considered necessary.
